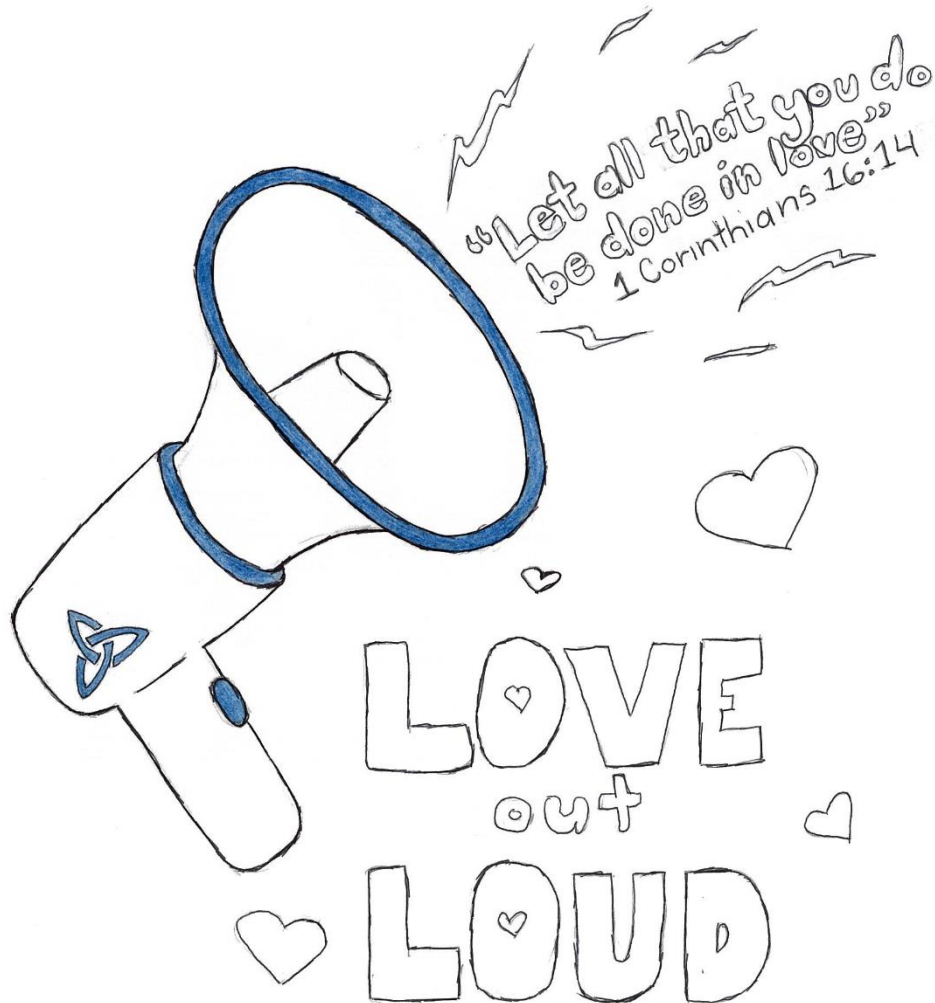

Trinity Christian School has held the Work-A-Thon (WAT) in the spring for the last 24 years. It provides hands-on learning that not only **shapes** and **challenges** students but also impacts people outside and around Trinity by ministering directly to them as well as raising funds for our school.

Questions and Answers:

What is the Work-A-Thon?

It is a two-part event:

- **Helping the Community** – This year during the spring, Trinity students, faculty, and parents will volunteer their time and effort in order to assist others. Families will decide how they can safely serve others.
- **Fundraiser** - Students and families are encouraged to contact friends, family, and neighbors and ask them to sponsor them in the Work-A-Thon. The goal is to raise \$30,000 in financial support for our school. We need EVERY student and EVERY family to participate in fundraising. Fundraising is done through the month of April and money needs to be received by April 30 to be counted towards incentives.

How much should I ask for someone to sponsor me?

- Any amount is wonderful, but a sponsorship of \$25 or more would be greatly appreciated. Students can let sponsors know that they can earn a casual day and prizes based on the amount of money they raise.

How are donations made?

- Donors can donate online at www.trinitychristian.net or mail a check to 299 Ridge Ave, Pittsburgh, PA 15221. Checks should be made out to Trinity Christian School or TCS. This year we are accepting checks or online donations ONLY. If someone gives a family a cash donation, we ask the family to write a check or donate online for them. Each check should have the student(s) name in the memo for them to receive credit.

Is my donation tax deductible and can I get a tax receipt?

- All donations are tax deductible. Donors can print a receipt with an online donation. For donations mailed in, a year end receipt will be mailed for \$100 or more. However, the donor may request a donation receipt for any amount given.

What will we be doing for the Work-A-Thon?

Rewards and Incentives:

When kids work hard, we want to encourage them in their efforts. Below are the prizes that will be awarded to students and classes. Sponsorships need to be received by **Friday April 30, 2021** to count towards incentive.

Individual Prizes:

When you reach the following amounts, you will be eligible for:

\$15 – Candy

\$75 - Comfort Day May 6, 2021

\$150 – Entry into drawing for a \$50 gift card – get another entry for each \$150 raised.

2 Drawings

1) Elementary Students

2) Middle and High School Students

\$400 – Choose a single admission to Kennywood or Sandcastle or Idlewild

Family Prize

Each family that raises \$1,000 or more will earn 2 additional single admission tickets to your choice Kennywood or Sandcastle or Idlewild

Class prizes

Each class that has 100% participation (meaning each student needs to raise at least \$15)

K-6 - Donut party and an **extra** recess

7-12 - Donut party and a **recess**

Fundraising methods - Ways to reach your goal

The keys to fundraising are relationships, personal interaction, honesty, and the willingness to ask. Family, friends, co-workers, church members, neighbors and businesses will usually support a worthy cause when asked. Remember, you are not asking for money for yourself; you are asking your sponsors to join you in supporting an important cause.

Personal Letters/Phone Calls/In Person

Letters and emails are a great way to ask. We have included a letter in this packet, on the next page, that you can copy and mail out. When sending a letter, include a return envelope. We recommend a follow up phone call for all emails and letters you have sent out. Personal calls are a highly effective means of soliciting and a great way to follow up after reaching out through social media. Also included is a sponsorship page to track donations if you are collecting them in person. Please keep in mind if you collect cash from someone, we ask that your family write a check for all cash donations this year.
