Questions and Answers:

What is the Work-A-Thon?

It is a two-part event:

- **Helping the Community** – On May 7, 2026, Trinity students, faculty, and parents will volunteer their time and effort to assist others. They will go to a variety of locations such as community pools and parks, churches, and local food banks. Some tasks will include sorting food, cleaning, and doing lawn work. In other words, Trinity students give back!
- **Fundraiser** - Students and families are encouraged to contact friends, family, and neighbors and ask them to sponsor them in the Work-A-Thon. The goal is to raise \$50,000 in financial support for our school. We need EVERY student and EVERY family to participate in fundraising. Fundraising is done now through April and money needs to be received by May 5th to be counted towards incentives.

How much should I ask for someone to sponsor me?

- Any amount is wonderful, but a sponsorship of \$25 or more would be greatly appreciated. Please let sponsors know that students can earn a casual day, and prizes based on the amount of money they raise.

How are donations made?

- Donors can donate online at www.trinitychristian.net (top right>Donate>Work-A-Thon) or by a check made out to Trinity Christian School. They can mail a check to 299 Ridge Ave, Pittsburgh, PA 15221. Each check should have the student(s) name in the memo for them to receive credit.

We have multiple kids in our family; how are donations handled?

- All donations will be equally split between the students in a family unless the donor specifically directs differently.

Is my donation tax deductible, and can I get a tax receipt?

- All donations are tax deductible. Donors can print a receipt with an online donation. For donations brought or mailed in, a year end receipt will be mailed for \$250 or more as long as a mailing address is provided. However, the donor may request a donation receipt for any amount given.

What will we be doing for the Work-A-Thon?

- Students, faculty, and parent volunteers will go into the city to serve and show God's love. They will be helping at food pantries, community centers, churches, parks, pools, and other community locations to work hard and bless these places. Many of these establishments depend on our student workday to make the necessary improvements to their facilities. Specifically, our volunteers will be raking, sorting food and clothes, cleaning toys, doing yard work, interacting with the elderly, cleaning, and serving in various other ways.

Rewards and Incentives:

When kids work hard, we want to encourage them in their efforts. Below are the prizes that will be awarded to students and families. Sponsorships need to be received by **Tuesday May 5, 2026**, to count towards incentive.

Individual Prizes:

When you reach the following amounts, you will be eligible for:

\$25 – Candy

\$75 - Comfort Day May 8, 2026

\$150 – Entry into drawing for a \$50 gift card – get another entry for each \$150 raised.

\$500 – Choose a single admission to Kennywood or Sandcastle or Idlewild or \$25 gift card

Family Prize

Each family that raises \$1,400 or more will earn 2 additional single admission tickets to your choice of Kennywood or Sandcastle or Idlewild or (2) \$25 gift cards.
